The Fir BT is now a snag with the scribe "¼ S" showing plainly on the loose bark.  
I reset the corner from the notes, putting in a 3" x 4 ft. Cedar post and marked ¼ S11 and ¼ S12 on post.  
I marked two BTs which bear:  
12" I.Cedar bears S.70°W., 39 lks. mkd. T29S R4W ¼ S12 BT.  
18" Red Fir bears N.70°E., 40 lks. mkd. T29S R4W ¼ S11 BT.
