

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION NE Cor. Hadley DLC #37

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Original DLC survey by Burnett & Bowman under Contract date 1855. (D.L.C. Records Book, page 533) ----- Set a post marked as per instructions from which; A White Oak, 9" dia., bears S.12½°W., 136 lks.
J.W. Cole - 1921 - FB 50 Pg 41 - "Old" Cor. Book Pg 126 ----- I renew this corner from the orig. BT which had been chopped open then over grown again causing scribe marks to rot off. I ran N.12°30'E., 89.7' and set an Oak post 4"x4"x40" also a 2"x18" brass tube & erected a mound of rock from which I mkd: An Oak, 30" dia., bears S.80°E., 73.7'

File 67/28-2 ----- Found - 1969 2½" brass cap on a 1½" O.D. iron pipe leaning southerly protruding 27" out of ground in a loose mount of stone. Brass cap when plumb is orientated NW'ly BC/IP when removed meas. 35" long. Fd. ¾" x 30" long iron rod under BC/IP Fd. 1921 1½" I.D. brass tube 3" under ground (recorded as 2" in 1921) Meas. taken from 1921 brass tube 9" dia., W.Oak now root hole bears S.12½°W., 89.8 ft. (agrees with rec.) OBT 30" dia., W.Oak now root hole bears S.80°E., 73.7 ft. (agrees with rec.) 1921 BT. New - 1969 BC/IP referenced & set lower. BC now protrudes 10" out of ground & 5" above a 2 ft. dia., mound of stone. ¾" I.R. is along north edge of BC/IP. Marks added to brass cap "RM ↑ NORTH 23.8 FT. DCSO 2009" 1969 BC/IP bears South 23.8 ft. from 1921 brass pipe. 5/8" by 30" long iron rod with DCSO alum cap marked: is set in center of DOUGLAS CO. brass pipe, protrudes NE 37 2009 5" out of ground. 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New - Taken from 1921 brass pipe.
27" dia., W.Oak double blazed & scribed "NE DLC 37 CS
BT" bears S.31°W., 112.7 ft.
36" dia., W.Oak double blazed & scribed "NE DLC 37 CS
BT" bears N.38½°W., 115.8 ft.
Note - Corner lies at bottom of small ravine.
Compass decl. 16½°E.
