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Found - No monument found. Found hole in ground believe this  
to be position of Byron's 1962 monument as it was  
reported found by Ruppert in 1977 on M 66-66. See  
1925 & 1962 renewals.  
Orig. 14" Black Oak bears N.65°E., 153.4' (rec.  
151.8') Tree now a 36" dia., with rotted center  
with partially healed previously opened blaze.  
Found reverse scribe mark "B" which we replaced  
in rotted out center of tree.  
A 14" now 15" trunk of forked white oak measuring  
12"x28" at base bears S.71 1/2°E., 85.4' (Rec.  
S.70 3/4°E) Tree has faint double blaze.  
Note - Found brass cap at location as determined by Byron  
1962 (of DCS0 records M 23-35, 1962 Byron renewal  
of the 1/4 cor. to secs. 26 & 27) bears N.80 1/2°W.,  
113.4'. Byron records N.80 1/2°W., 113.13' and  
orig.records show corner at N.82 1/2°W., 113.1' to  
1/4 S27 & S26. (Cont. Next Page)
