Set a post, from which
A B.Oak 30" dia., bears S.75°E., 51 lks.
A W.Oak 8" dia., bears S.5°E., 108 lks.

Cole, Smick, Richardson, Taylor - For: A. Taylor - July 6-8, 1921 - F.B. 51 pgs. 42-46

Set Oak stake also, from which stump of 30" B.Oak bears S.75°E., 33.7 ft.
A 24" W.Oak bearing chopped scars, bears S.2½30'E., 71.3 ft.
Marked new trees:
A W.Oak 30" dia., bears S.40°E., 113.5 ft.
A W.Oak 30" dia., bears S.79°E., 176.0 ft.
Set iron plow frame 15" below ground.

Found - Both BTs, as set by Cole, 1921. Check for bearing & distances.
SE BT alive, center rotted, found C L scribe.
The S.79°E. BT, center rotted at old blaze but found BT scribe at base of tree.
Looked for old plow frame at corner. Could not find.
D. Rice says he leveled field.
We also find original BT, recorded S.5°E., 76.2 ft. to be South, 76.2 ft. Center and all of orig. blaze rotted. No scribe.
Set 1" I.P. with brass cap mkd: S.W. Cor. D.L.C. 47 T29S R6W County Surveyors Office.
New BTs -24" W.Oak N.5°W., 33.8 ft. scribed S.W. Cor. DLC 47 CS BT.
20" W.Oak S.85½°W., 134.4 ft. scribed S.W. Cor. DLC 47 CS BT.

The SW. cor. of DLC 47, perpetuated by Hicks, in 1917, further perpetuated by Cole, in 1921, & remonumented by Byron, in 1954,, monumented with an iron post, 1" dia., firmly set 10" below the surface of the ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd.
