A 22" W.Oak, bears N.79°E., 84.2' (rec. N.80°E.,
81.1') with visible scribing in an almost healed
double blaze.
A 30" B.Oak, bears S.7°E. 71.4' (rec. S.4°E., 75.2')
with a well healed double blaze.
Set - I move brass cap S.59°34'20"W., 4.31'. Cap is set 7"
above ground in a 18" mound of stone and stamped
"Reset 1977" above "1969".
I set a 5/8"x30" I.R. in orig. brass cap location
with a 1½" Alum. cap set 6" above ground in a 18"
mound of stone and mkd. "Douglas Co." 1977
