A B. Oak, 12" diam., bears N.54°W, 30 lks.
A Fir, 24" diam., bears N.44°E, 28 lks.

Re-establishment of corners - Fred Mensch, U.S. Deputy
Surveyor - under date of April 18, 1924 (DCSO Vol 14 Pg 6012)

Intersect the Hathorn ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 & 18, located
by measurement from the original bearing trees. The marks
are grown over, but the blazes are plain.

At the exact cor. point
Set an iron post, 3 ft long, 1" diam., 28" in the ground, for
¼ sec. cor. of sec. 13 only, with brass cap marked

from which (the original bearing trees)
A fir, 30" diam., bears N.45°E., 28 lks., (not N.44°E.)
A B. Oak, 14" diam., bears N.52°W., 30 lks., (not
N.54°W.)

New bearing trees:
A fir, 16" diam., bears S.52°W., 19 lks., mkd. ¼ S 13 BT.
A fir, 8" diam., bears N.87°W., 41 lks., mkd. ¼ S 13 BT.

Found - Brass cap at corner & SW. BT., shows good scar.
Find low cut stump that checks N.87°W., not S.87°W.

The ¼ sec. cor., monumented with an iron post 1" dia., firmly
set, projecting 12" above ground with brass cap mkd in 1924,
from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A Fir stump 30" dia., bears N.45°E., 28 lks. dist., with
healed blaze.

A root hole bears N.52°W., 30 lks. dist. with a down and
decayed Oak alongside size indeterminate, no marks
