An orig. 36" Fir, now a 70" D. Fir snag with faint
scribing "¼" visible on deteriorating bark blaze,
bears N.3°W., 73.9 ft. (Rec. N.7°W., 73.9 ft.)

A 1924 BT, a 24" now 36" D. Fir alive with well healed
single blaze, bears S.19½°W., 37 ft.

No trace of original corner post.

New BT-A 13" diam., Fir, scribed "¼ S12 CS BT" on a double
blaze, bears N.5°W., 48.6 ft.
