A Fir 24" dia., bears S.85°E., 27 lks. mkd. C¼ S21 BT.

A Madrone 16" dia., bears N.50°W., 80 lks. mkd. C¼ S21 BT.

Reported as not found.

Corner is in 1974 fire area, which was logged in 1975.

Found possible BT log, which is 24" D.Fir log w/axe marks on
burned blaze w/blue paint. No indication where stump was.

With metal detector, did not find brass cap & iron pipe.

Apparently IP was dislodged during logging in 1975.

Note - Blazed N-S centerline is still evident. E-W
centerline has been obliterated in the vicinity.

From end of Byron Creek Rd. take dirt driveway ½
mile to pink ribbon.
