

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION Center 1/4 Cor. for Sec. 3

Alias	Description
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Arthur Boyer, #1581 - Wit: H.L. Northcraft; John Fletcher -  
For: Arthur Gilbert - Oct. 1958 - M 12-72

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Set at intersection N & S and E & W, midsection lines.  
Drove 3" x 3" Fir stake, and scribed:  
24" Fir stump N.10°E., 34 ft. on slope, "Cen S3 T29S R7W  
1581 BT".  
12" leaning Fir S.33°E., 14.5 ft., "Cen S3 1/16 S3 T29S  
R7W BT".

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Glenn S. Baughman, LS #536 - For: Douglas County Lumber Co.  
-Aug. 1980 - C.S. File 58/144 and M 85-35

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Found - 16" D.Fir with old blaze bears S.79°E., 7.3 ft.  
Set 5/8" x 30" Iron Rod.  
New BTs -6" Fir bears N.36°W., 27.0 ft. scribed C 1/4 S3 BT.  
10" Fir bears N.72°E., 12.6 ft. scribed C ¼ S3 BT.

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Point for the center ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 3, at intersection  
with the E. and W. center line of sec. 3.  
Set an Iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 24" in the ground, with  
brass cap mkd:  
T 29 S R 7 W  
C 1/4 S 3  
1981

from which  
A Fir 19" dia., bears S.35½°W., 39½ lks. dist., mkd. C ¼  
S3 BT.  
A Fir 10" dia., bears N.75½°W., 39½ lks. dist., mkd. C ¼  
S3 BT.

From this point, a corner established by Boyer in 1957, bears  
N.61°42'W., 0.222 chs. dist., determined from the remains of  
BTs mkd. by Boyer

A Fir stump 20" dia., bears N.10°W., 46 lks. dist., with  
illegible scribe marks visible on open blaze.  
A Fir 18" dia., bears S.33°E., 22 lks. dist. with healed  
blaze.

From this same point, a corner established by Baughman in  
1980, bears S.71°34'W., 0.19 chs. dist., monumented with an  
iron rod, 5/8" dia., firmly set, projecting 4" above ground,  
from which bearing trees mkd. by Baughman

A Fir 11" dia., bears N.75 ¾°E., 19 lks. with scribe  
marks C 1/4 S3 BT visible on open blaze.  
A Fir 12" dia., bears N.39½°W., 39 ks. dist., with scribe  
marks C ¼ S3 BT visible on open blaze.
