- 1924 GLO brass cap 6" above ground properly marked.
- A 8", now 13" Fir, bears N.12°E., 32.3 ft. with healed blaze.
- A 7" cedar, down and rotted at orig. bearing and dist.. (S.60°E., 4 ft.) scribing found "AP 2 Tr 52 BT" (Rec. "AP 3 Tr 51 BT").

New BT -

- A 6" Cedar bears S.70°E., 2.4 ft. scribed "AP 2 Tr 52 CS BT" in double blaze.
