Found - 1968 Shrum 2½" dia., alum. cap (properly mkd) on a 1" I.D. iron pipe projecting 12" above ground. Evidence of one OBT, a very distinct and large roothole near rec. B&D for SE BT.
An 11" dia., 1½ ft. tall rotted fir stump showing evid. of healed blaze; bears N.44½°E., 22.2 ft. (per rec) 1968
A 15" dia., 11 ft. tall D.Fir snag with a fully healed double blaze; bears S.4°E., 23.8 ft. (rec bearing S.5½°E. to blaze face) 1968
A 12" dia., Cedar with a FHDB; bears N.2°W., 11.8 ft. (as per rec) 1968
New - A 12" dia., D.Fir scribed "T30SR1WS1" "CSBT" on a double blaze; bears N.32¾°E., 19.8 ft.
 A 10" dia., D.Fir scribed "T30SR1WS12CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.51°E., 28.2 ft.
 A 4" dia., Madrone trunk in a multi-trunked shrubby tree scribed "X" "BT" on a high-low blaze; bears S.68°W., 10.0 ft. (B & D are to cnt'r of base of scribed trunk)
Note - Mon is in NW cor of logged land. SE quadrant is old Fir rerod. Other quads are old growth forest. Mon is approx 300 ft. east from forest rd.
