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GLO survey by Peter Applegate, US Deputy Surveyor under contract #571 dated April 10, 1891 - (DCSO records Vol. 26 Page(s) 11134-5)

Set a stone 14x10x8", 9" in the ground for cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, & 33 mkd with 2 notches on W & 4 notches on E edges, from which

- A W.Fir, 24" dia. bears S.5°W., 22 lks mkd: T31S R2E S5 BT
- A larch, 30" dia., bears S.23°E., 11 lks., mkd: T31S R2E S4 BT.
- A larch 48" dia., bears N.30°E., 44 lks., mkd: T30S R2E S33 BT.
- A larch, 6" dia., bears N.37°W., 68 lks., mkd: T30S R2E S32 BT.

GLO dependent resurvey by Leonard Carter, Public Land Surveyor & George F Dawson, Jr. Transit man, under Group No. 175, surveyed April/Aug. 1937 - (DCSO Vol. 56 Pages 21849-50)

The orig. cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, & 33, which is a sandstone, 16x12x10", firmly set, mkd. with four notches on E & two notches on W edge.

I now change this cor. to refer to secs. 4 & 5 only.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft long, 2" dia., 27" in the ground, with the orig. stone deposited at the base, for cor. of secs. 4 & 5 only, with brass cap marked:

T30S R2E
S 32
S 5 S 4
T31S R2E

1937 from which

- A W.Fir, 50" dia., bears N.30°E., 44 lks., mkd. T30S R2E S33 BT. I obliterate the marks on this tree. (Old BT)
- A W.Fir, 35" dia., bears S.23°E., 12 lks. blaze healed. I do not open (Old BT)
- A W.Fir, 25" dia., bears S.5°W., 22 lks., blaze healed. I do not open (Old BT)
- A W.Fir, 9" dia., bears N.37°W., 68 lks., mkd. T30S R2E S32 BT. I obliterate the marks on this tree. (Old BT)

(S.89°09'E., 1.65 chains to Cor. Secs. 32 & 33)

Found - Firmly set, exposed 15" in mound of stone, the 2" iron pipe with 1937 properly marked GLO brass cap as recorded by L. Carter.

TOWNSHIP 30 RANGE 02E POINT IDENTIFIER # 279100

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Orig. fir snag, 50" bears N.30°E., 31.67 ft. to center. (Record N.30°E., 29.04 ft.)
Fir snag, 11" with upper blaze axed out bears N.37°W., 46.7 ft. to center. (Rec. N.37°W., 44.88 ft.)
Note - Carter notes obliterating marks on the above trees in 1937.
Shasta R.Fir, 37" with healed blazes, bears S.30°E., 7.50 ft. to center. (Rec. S.23°E., 7.26 ft.)
W.Fir 26" with healed blazes, bears S.5°W., 14.00 ft. to center (Rec. S.5°W., 14.52 ft.)
New BT- Shasta R.Fir, 20" bears N.82°W., 42.00 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze. I mark CS BT.
