Set a Fir post, no stones available, 3 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. on W. bdy. sec. 18, marked ¼ S18 on E. face, from which
 A Fir 18" dia., bears N.40°E., 48 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S18 BT
 A Sugar Pine 16" dia., bears S.60°E., 26 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S18 BT.

I find both BTs, now stumps, each shows good scribing. I also find 1¼" I.P. set for corner with 6" x 2" painted white yewood post alongside. (The brass cap at E¼ S13 bears South 86.0 ft. not 92.4 ft.)
From the 1¼" I.P., now 30" Fir stump bears N.66°E., 31.7 ft., not N.40°E.
Now 30" S.Pine stump bears S.27°E., 17.2 ft. now S.60°E.
Bearing trees face to 1¼" I.P.

Found - 1¼" Iron pipe, found in 1962, alongside of which is a painted white 6"x2" yew wood post mkd. ¼ S18 30S 2W.
 An Orig. 30" badly decayed sugar Pine stump, bears S.27°E., 17.2 ft. (Rec. S.60°E.)
 An Orig. 30" badly decayed Fir stump, bears N.66°E., 31.7 ft. (Rec. N.40°E., chop marks visible.)
New BTs- 6" Cedar bears N.62°E., 29.6 ft.
 5" Fir bears S.20°E., 14.0 ft.
 Both scribed "¼ S18 BT".

Found - 1¼" iron pipe with scribed yew post alongside.

 13" D.Fir bears S.19¾°E., 14.2 ft. (rec. S.20°E., 14.0 ft) healed face and tag.
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Badly decayed S.Pine stump at record. S.27°E., 17.2
ft. some visible scribing. Indeterminate dia.,
approx. 1 ft. tall.
Note - Corner is 0.6 ft. above ground and approx. 50 ft.
west of draw.
Metal U-post is approx 3.0 ft. east of corner.
