Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1" dia., 28" in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 10" dia., bears S.26°E., 40 lks., mkd: 1/4 S12 BT.

A hemlock, 24" dia., bears N.72 1/2°W., 53 lks., mkd: 1/4 S1 BT

Found - Projecting 2" the original 1" dia. iron pipe with GLO brass cap (properly) mkd. as recorded by H. Raymond in 1928.

Orig. BTs fd as follows:

W.Fir, 24" dia., with healed single blaze brs. S.16°E, 26.31 ft. to center. Record: S.26°E., 26.40 ft.

Hemlock stump, 26" dia., 6 ft. high, marked "1/4 S1BT" in exposed single face, brs. N.72 1/2°W, 35.25 ft. to center. Record: N.72 1/2°W, 34.98 ft Note: Marks on this tree appear to have been "knife scribed".

New - I mark a new tree CS BT:

W.Fir, 14" dia., brs. N.2°E., 53.17 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze.

Note - Corner lies about 400 ft west of location marker on 12" dia. fir stob, alongside road.

V=18 1/2°

Found - At corner position exposed 2" the 1" dia. galv. iron pipe with a 2 1/2" dia. brass cap set by the GLO in 1928 and (properly) marked:

Aluminum post 1 ft. to the west of monument.

BTs recorded by Herbert Raymond of the GLO in 1928 found and measured to center at base:

W.Fir now 32" dia. with healed single blaze brs. S.16°E., 26.8 ft. Record; 26.3 ft.

Hemlock high stump, rotted w/"1/4 S1 BT" in detached face brs. record; N.72 1/2°W., 35.3 ft. CONT.

TOWNSHIP 30 RANGE 03E POINT IDENTIFIER # 640600

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BT recorded in 1977 found with healed double blazes and measured to center at lower blaze:
W. fir now 25" dia. brs. record N.2°E., 53.2 ft.
New - Marked new BTs "CS" "BT" and measured to center at lower blaze:
Hemlock 17" dia. brs. S.84½°W., 48.1 ft.
P.Pine 8" dia. brs. N.4½°W., 12.1 ft.
Note - Corner lies approx. 400 ft west of gravel road.
V = 15°40'
