

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION 1/4 Cor. Secs. 1 & 6, T30-4E

Alias	Description
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GLO survey by Herbert N Raymond, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, under Special Instructions dated Dec. 27, 1920 & Sept. 9, 1927 - (DCSO records Vol. 26 Page(s) 11060)

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1" dia., 30" in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

S 1 | S 6
1927

from which

- A fir, 8" dia., bears S.75°E., 40 lks., mkd: 1/4 S6 BT.
- A pine, 26" dia., bears N.15°W., 20 lks., mkd: 1/4 S1 BT.

Found - Projecting 4", the original 1" dia. iron pipe with standard GLO brass cap (properly) marked, as recorded by H. Raymond in 1927.

Original BTs fd as follows:

Sawed fir stump, 18" dia., bears record S.75°E., 26.40 ft. to center.

W.Pine, 37" dia., with healed single blaze, brs N.15°W., 12.8 ft to center. Record; N.15°W., 13.20 ft.

New - I re-mark this tree CS BT and mk a new tree CS-BT: W.Fir, 9" dia., brs S.55 1/4°E., 16.1 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze.

Note - Corner lies 66 ft. North of ridge top C. SE. Decl. 20 1/2°

Found - At the corner position, exposed 4", the 1" dia. galv. iron pipe with a 2 1/2" dia. galv. iron pipe with a 2 1/2" dia. brass cap set by the GLO in 1927, (properly) marked:

BTs recorded by Raymond in 1927 found and measured to center of trees at base:

Sawed fir stump brs. record; S.75°E., 26.4 ft.

W.Pine, now 41" dia. with healed double blazes brs. record; N.15°W., 13.2 ft.

W.Fir snag with healed double blazes (origin unknown) brs. S.60°E., 16.0 ft.

New - Mark new BTs "CS" "BT" and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

Hemlock 10" dia. brs. S.10 1/2°W., 16.5 ft.

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Note - Hemlock 9" dia. brs. N.82°E., 7.9 ft.
Corner lies approx. 900 ft. south of gravel road.
