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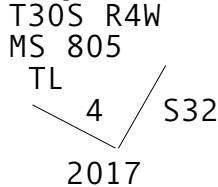

 A fir, 12" dia., bears S.57°20'E., 21.0 ft. and
 A fir, 5" dia., bears N.76°18'W., 34.7 ft.
Each blazed and scribed BT T 4-805

Corner No. 4, Therodore Lode, perpetuated by person(s) unknown, monumented with an iron pipe, 1" dia., firmly set, projecting 20" above ground, from which an original BT

Set a stainless steel post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 25" in the ground, directly over the iron rod 36" long, with brass cap mkd.
