Found - An Axle shaft. We find this monument to be 1¼" dia.,
steel axle shaft (unmarked) firmly set and
protruding approx. 4" above ground. Monument is
set in approx. 2.5 ft. dia., rough mound of river
rock (Rocks have been painted pink) 1954
A steel fence post protruding approx. 4.5 ft. above
ground is set northeasterly approx. 0.5 ft. from
fd. axle.

No evidence of orig. BT is found.

A 46" B.Oak is now a clear root-hole depression, the
approx. center which bears N.58½°W., 43.5 ft. (as
per rec.) 1954

Monument is substantial and solid, we do not alter.

New - A triple-trunk madrone with trunks averaging 28" in
dia., scribed "WSW DLC 49 CS" "BT" on a double
blaze on the most westerly trunk. The CRC bears
N.57°E., 288.8 ft.

A 46" dia., W.Oak (triple trunk but not fully separate until above 5 ft.) is scribed "WSW DLC 49 CS" "BT" on a double blaze on the most northerly trunk. The CRC bears S.27¼°W., 224.6 ft. The main NE (i.e. most Easterly) corner post of a 75 ft x 75 ft barn bears S.61½°W., 705.8 ft. The center of 2½ ft. dia., circular cobble lined well (well is mostly earth filled and is now approx. 3 ft. deep) bears N.50¼°W., 107.0 ft.

Note - Monument is near top of a low SW'ly running ridge in open pasture land. A seasonal, southerly running, stream is east approx. 480 ft. Compass decl. 15½°E.
