Location of OBT now falls in dirt cat-road; no evidence remains.

A 24" fir, now a 38" dia., D.Fir with a fully rehealed blaze; bears N.71°E., 28.1 ft. (as per 1974 rec.) orig. dist. good for face measured. Undated Wenderoth BT

A 12" madrone, now a 19" dia approx. 25 ft tall dead and rotting madrone snag, with a partially healed single blaze showing illegible scribing; bears S.67½°E., 55.0 ft. (rec. S.66°E., 54.1 ft.) 1957

A 17" D.Fir now a 31" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed single blaze; bears S.10½°E., 34.5 ft. (as per 1974 rec.) BT first called in 1974 renewal but referenced back to Wenderoth 1949 survey.

New - 10" dia., B.Oak scribed "SWDLC51CS" "BT" bears S.27°W., 9.2 ft.

A 12" dia., madrone scribed "SWDLC51CS" "BT" bears N.41½°W., 32.1 ft.

Note - BC mon. is at west end of flat-topped ridge running east. Land slopes gently up to west. Land is forested with Oak, Madrone, Fir, & Maple. Forest is thinned to West.

Compass decl. 15½°E.
