1963 BTs are same as 1923 BTs. We find noted fence corner (with fences running N-S and E) bears N.55°E., 6.0 ft. (rec. N.65°E., 5.0 ft.)
Monument good as found, we do not disturb.

New - A double trunk madrone of which the most westerly 9" dia., trunk is scribed "NW DLC 52 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears N.34¾°E., 72.7 ft.
A 19" dia., Ponderosa Pine scribed "NW DLC 52 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.75½°E., 48.4 ft.
A 12" dia., W.Oak scribed "NW DLC 52 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.27½°E., 87.5 ft.
A 16" dia., Ponderosa pine scribed "NW DLC 52" "CSBT" on a double blaze; bears S.2¾°W., 45.3 ft.

Note - On very gently south sloping pastureland at west edge of a mainly oak & pine woodland.
Compass decl. 15½°E.
