8" Oak now 12" Oregon Ash, scribing "NW DLC 62 BT" visible on partially healed single blaze bears N.8°E., 11.4 ft. (Rec. N.6°E., 10.9 ft.) 1974 BT

8" Oak now 9" Oregon Ash scribing NW DLC 62 BT" visible on partially healed single blaze bears S.80½°W., 40.8 ft. to pistol butt root crown (rec. S.79°W., 41.2 ft.) 1974 BT.

30" W.Oak, previously double trunk, evidence of healed blaze visible bears S.66½°W., 34.7 ft. (rec. calls 14" double W.Oak N.68°35'W., 34.7 ft.) Wenderoth BT from 1951, opened tree & fd. reverse scribe "BT"

New - 16" dia., Big leaf maple, leans westerly, double blazed & scribed "NW DLC 62 CS BT" bears S.41¼°E., 83.5 ft.

Note - Corner lies on high bank of S. Umpqua River approx. 36 ft. from waters edge.  
Compass decl. 16¾°E.

Fd as described in 2005 except:  
1974 renewal BT An 8" Oak (correctly identified as an Oregon Ash in 2005) now a still alive but broken 9" dia., 3 ft. tall Oregon Ash stub with only the edge of a healed blaze scar remaining; bears S.80½°W., 40.8 ft. (as per 2005 record)  
We re-nail all fd. BT tags & place a new tag on Fd. Ash stub.

Corner is fd as described by DCS0 in 2005 except as follows:  
Found - 12" dia., Oregon Ash, now a 13" dia., Oregon ash (Blazed as noted in 2005) bears N.6°E., 10.9 ft. (as per 1974 rec)  
9" Oregon Ash, now a rotted and broken 10"x3' ash stump with no blaze evidence remaining. The rest of this BT, missing its blaze, but still having the 2005 BT tag attached was recently fd approx 84 miles down river at the Bullock Bridge (T24S R7W S13) This stumps B&D agree with 2005 measurement.

New in 2005 Big leaf Maple, now 18" dia., with double blaze almost full healed, bearing and distance as per record.

New - A 12" dia., Ash scribed "NW DLC 62" "CS BT" on a double blaze; bears N.73½°W., 30.8 ft.

Note - Compass decl. 15¼°E.  
This corner previously described as being on the High Bank of the South Umpqua River is now situated at the toe of the River's left high bank.
