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Found - 1970 County 2½" Brass cap on a 1¼" O.D. Iron pipe  
protruding 1" above ground.

27" now 30" dia. 4 ft. high tipped out D.Fir stump  
with a fully healed double blaze, remains of root  
and part of broken up trunk, bears N.83°E., 8.2  
ft. (agrees w/rec. per survey M 39-45)

10" now 12" dia., Maple with a partially healed  
double blaze, illegible scribe marks visible,  
bears N.22°W., 7.0 ft. (agrees w/rec. M 39-45)

New BTs - 22" D.Fir double blazed and scribed "N 1/16 S4 CS  
BT" bears S.5°W., 22.0 ft.

24" dia. 1 ft. high D.Fir stump, a ½" sq. x 8¼" long  
Iron boat spike with a 1 1/8" dia. healed, is set  
through BT tag on top of stump, top of boat spike  
is stamped "BO 1 1989" and bears N.55°E., 28.2  
ft.
