A Y.Pine 40" dia., bears S.35°E., 200 lks. dist.
A R.Fir 60" dia., bears N.35°E., 182 lks.
A B.Oak 4" dia., bears N.65°W., 28 lks.
A B.Oak 5" dia., bears S.15°W., 85 lks.

GL0 Survey by Oscar F. Thiel, under Contract #658 dated May 21, 1896 (DCSO records, Vol. 17 Page 7169)

At the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, which I re-establish by setting a Fir post 3 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground mkd. T30S S11 on NE., R5W S14 on SE., S15 on SW., and S10 on NW faces with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on E. edges and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

BLM resurvey by Roseberry and Jelley under Group #662 - Surveyed Oct. 1967/June 1969 (DCSO records, Vol. 38 Pages 15526-27)

The Sec. cor. perpetuated and recorded by Markham, 1958, from original evidence no longer in existence, monumented with an iron pipe, 3/4" dia., firmly set, projecting 6" above ground, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Markham:
A Fir 8" dia., bears N.17¼°E., 69 lks. with scribe marks S11 B visible on partially healed double blaze.
A root hole bears N.87¼°E., 62 lks. with a down fir alongside, 17" dia., with scribe marks S14 BT visible on partially healed blaze. (Cont. Next Page)
