Found - 1¼" O.D. iron pipe leans northerly 0.4 ft. protruding 1.6 ft. out of ground. Fence corner with fences running north & S.35°E., near corner.
22" now 32" D.Fir healed blaze visible & BT tag dated 1957 bears S.32°E., 11.5 ft. B. Irving mentions this tree on M20-23, his rec. was S.20°E., 11.0 ft.
30" now 42" B.Oak previously opened blazed with rotted center bears N.31½°W., 11.9 ft. agrees w/rec. OBT
New - 16" B.Oak, healed blaze visible bears S.55½°E., 36.8 ft. (Per M20-23 computed rec. S.59°20'29"E., 35.53') This tree was marked by Irving in 1948 as BT to sections 12 & 13 of T30-6, now witness to both corners (M20-23 rec. 18" B.Oak bears S.3°27'W., 168.4 ft. [B&D between BT & sec. cor.])
33" B.Oak burned unhealed blaze visible bears N.53½°W., 37.2 ft. This tree was marked by Irving in 1948 as BT to sections 7 & 18 only of T30-5, now witness to both corners (M20-23 rec. 28" B.Oak bears N.25°W., 149.5 ft. {B&D between BT & Sec. corner} computed rec. per M20-23 is N.53°42'19"W., 36.42')
