I renewed the cor. from orig. BTs.
I set a sandstone 8 x 10 x 15 mkd. CL. 39 C.S. from which
Stump of orig. BT with scribe marks visible N.3°E., 25.8'.
A B.Oak 26", nearly dead, bears N.82°E., 54.0 ft. blazes
face westerly, top blaze chopped out but old wood
bearing scribe marks were found in the hollow of the
tree when we chopped open the lower blaze. I also
found a portion of scribe marks below.
This corner does not correspond with all calls of the field
notes but I could find no position that would fulfill all
calls.
I marked new trees:
A W.Oak 10" dia., bears S.49°30'E., 45.5 ft.
A W.Oak 10" dia., bears S.52°30'W., 39.0 ft.
