Found - No trace of brass cap, broken off, found pipe in concrete, probably had brass cap attached, cement has been moved from logging operations.

12" D.Fir now stump, S.13°E., 22.0 ft., no scribing found on burnt face.
8" laurel N.18°E., 18.0 ft. no scribing on face.
