A sawed Fir stump 26" dia., bears N.63°E., 54 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on open blaze.
A shattered Fir stump 16" dia., bears N.36°E., 57½ lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S3 BT visible on open blaze.
