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Found - Orig. 18" B.Oak S.49°E., 38.9 ft. This tree is now 28". It showed two good scars. I open to old faces which are now partly rotted, but I believe we found reverse scribing, parts of "BT". Call to North checks OK.

No trace of SE orig. BT. found.
