23" now 31" dia., B.Oak, (meas. 2 ft. above ground due to low fork) healed single blaze visible bears N.89°W., 26.5 ft. (agrees w/rec) 1937 BT
12" fir stump now 13" dia. x 1 ft. tall rotted out stump bears S.51°W., 46.5 ft. (rec. S.51°W., 47.5 ft.) 1937 BT continued next page
