Found both BTs and iron rod as recorded.
New BT - 6" R.Fir bears N.65°W., 19.2 ft. scribed ¼ S25 CSBT
Logging road bears West, 100 ft.

BLM resurvey by James E. Jelley and Charles E. Akin, Jr., Cadastral Surveyors, under Group #'s 734 and 829, surveyed April 1971/Oct. 1973 - (DCSO records Vol. 37 Page(s) 15144-45)

The ¼ sec. cor., perpetuated and recorded by Evans in 1953, and subsequently perpetuated by Byron in 1963, monumented with an iron pin 5/8" dia., firmly set, projecting 8" above ground, from which the remaining original bearing tree:

A Laurel 35" dia., bears N.28°W., 218 lks. dist. with fragmentary scribe marks visible on decayed blaze.
and a bearing tree mkd. by Evans:
A Pine 18" dia., bears S.10°W., 5½ lks. dist. with fragmentary scribe marks vis. on partially open blaze.
and a bearing tree mkd. by Byron:
A Fir 6" dia., bears N.60 ¾°W., 15 lks. dist. with healed blaze.

At the corner point
Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:

T 30 S R 7 W
1971

Deposit the iron pin alongside the iron post.

30" Laurel bears N.28°W., 143.9 ft., stump.
18" Pine bears S.10°W., 3.6 ft., stump.
New BTs - 13" Fir bears N.01°W., 37.5 ft. scribed ¼ S BT.
9" Madrone bears S.13°E., 51.5 ft. scribed ¼ S BT.
