This position is harmoniously related to existing original corners, has been recognized as the corner by adjacent landowners & is accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner position. Corner monumented with a 1963 DCSO brass cap, properly mkd. from which bearing trees mkd. by Evans

A Pine 15" dia., bears N.67 ¾°W., 43 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks vis. on partially opened blaze
