BLM dependent resurvey by Randolph E. Younis, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group No. 2849 - surveyed Sept. 2016/March 2017 - (DCSO Records Vol. 59 Page(s) 23619)

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 18, monumented with an iron post, 1½" dia., firmly set, projecting 9" above ground, with a brass cap (properly) mkd.

from which the remains of the bearing trees mkd. by Powell, in 1965, reported by Pieske in 1982-83

A cedar high stump, 26" dia., bears S.81½°E., 45.6 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, S.80°E., 46.2 ft.)

A fir, 29" dia., bears N.36¼°W., 51.5 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, N.32°W.)

and a new bearing tree

A cedar, 6" dia., bears S.19¼°E., 12.5 ft., mkd. ¼ S17 BT. Each new BT has a 2½"x ¼" magnetic nail (Mag Nail) driven at the base right side-center & each corner established or remonumented has a magnet deposited in a white plastic case at the base of the stainless steel post. Alum. Angle iron driven alongside each monument.
