A cedar tree, 7" dia., which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W side, from which
 A fir, 30" dia., bears S.40 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 34 $\frac{3}{4}$ lks., mkd: $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.
 A cedar, 6" dia., bears S.72°E., 39 lks., mkd: $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

BLM Dependent resurvey by James E. Jelley, Cadastral Surveyor under Group #477 surveyed July 1962 - (DCSO records Vol. 31 Page(s) 13173)

The Sec. cor. of secs 7 & 8, monumented with the orig. corner tree, a down and rotted cedar, 8" dia., with scribe marks visible on opened blaze, from which the original BTs:

- A down cedar, 8" dia., bears S.72°E., 39 lks., with scribe marks S BT visible on unhealed blaze.
- A down and rotted fir, 30" dia., bears S.40 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 34 $\frac{3}{4}$ lks., with no marks remaining.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " dia., 21" in the ground, with brass cap marked

- A cedar, 27" dia., bears N.49 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 98 lks., marked S8 BT.

Deposit the remains of orig. cor tree alongside the iron post

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 7 & 8, perpetuated by Jelley in 1962; monumented with an iron post, 2" dia., firmly set, projecting 6" above ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd. from which the bearing trees mkd. by Jelley

- A cedar, 41" dia., bears N.50 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 63.0 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, N.49 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 64.7 ft.)
- A fir, 30" dia., bears S.40 $\frac{3}{4}$ °W., 65.9 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, S.40°W., 66.7 ft.)
