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Line Tree originally bearing N.0°02'W. 2364.12' from the SESC Found - GLO line tree was a 36" D.Fir with 2 blazes on the North & 2 blazes on the South side bearing N.0°02'W., 2364.12' from the SESC NOW 46" D.Fir low stump with only 1 blaze remaining on the North side bearing N.0°07'W., 2365.8' from the SWSC & 4.3' east of line between E ¼ and SESC  
Scribe- 18" D.Fir, bears S.18°W., 17.3'. We scribe BT & tag tree.  
11" D. Fir, bears N.2°W., 20.25'. We scribe BT & tag tree.
