

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION Line tree between Secs. 22 & 23

At 45.70 chs north of Secs. 22, 23, 26, & 27
A fir, 24" dia.

Found - Orig. 24" line tree now 40" snag with visible marks on North and South faces.

New - Set 5/8"x40" Iron Rod With Orange Plastic Cap Marked Lone Rock Timber PLS 2291 on North Face of Original Line Tree

12" D.Fir bears N.5°E., 28.7 ft. to middle of line tree and 26.7 ft. to iron rod we scribe BT and nail aluminum bearing tree tag to the tree

9" D.Fir bears S.85°E., 21.3 ft. to middle of line tree and 21.2 ft. to iron rod we scribe BT and nail aluminum bearing tree tag to the tree

Note - Found original 24" line tree now a 40" snag with visible marks. We reference line tree by setting a 5/8"x40" iron rod with orange plastic cap on north face of line tree and making two bearing trees to line tree.
