Found - Incense Cedar, now 26" dia., N.45°E. 1.3 ft. Chopped out lower blaze & found scribed "BT" in perfect condition. Ring count proves it to be original scribing.  
Shattered Remnants of a Fir Stump (Approx 30" dia.) bears S.40°W. 6 ft.  
No Trace of other two bearing trees could be found.  
Set Brass Cap at Corner mkd S11|S12 T30S R9W County Surveyors  
S14|S13 Office, 1958  
Blazed & Scribed new BTs as follows:  
25" Incense Cedar, S.39°W. 43.2 ft. "T30S R9W S14 CS BT"  
23" Incense Cedar, S.6°E. 31.9 ft. "T30S R9W S13 CS BT."  
16" W. Fir N.13½°W.33.5 ft. "T30S R9W S11 CS BT."

The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, & 14, remonumented by Byron, in 1958, monumented with an iron post, 1½" dia., firmly set, projecting 10" above ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd. from which the remains of the orig. bearing trees  
A cedar, 39" dia., bears N.45°E., 1.3 ft., with scribe marks BT visible on opened blaze.  
A decayed stump, size and species indeterminate, bears S.40°W., 5.9 ft., with no marks visible. (Record, fir) and bearing trees mkd. by Byron  
A cedar, 26" dia., bears S.8½°E., 31.2 ft., with healed blaze.  
A cedar, 35" dia., bears S.40¼°W., 42.1 ft., with healed blaze.  
A fir, 25" dia., bears N.14½°W., 33.5 ft., with healed blaze.
