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Set a basalt stone 26x8x6", 8" in the ground to bedrock, supported by mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, & 18 mkd with 5 notches on E & 4 notches on S edges, from which

A fir, 36" dia., bears N.73°E., 108 lks., mkd: T31S R1E S8  
BT.

A fir, 18" dia., bears S.48°E., 65 lks., mkd: T31S R1E S17  
BT.

A fir, 30" dia., bears S.29°W., 90 lks., mkd: T31S R1E S18  
BT.

A fir, 50" dia., bears N.68°W., 79 lks., mkd: T31S R1E S7  
BT.

Note: It is impracticable to set iron post as bedrock is within a few inches of the surface and stones in sufficient number for supporting mound are not available.
