A larch, 16" dia., bears N.89°W., 140 lks., mkd:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT.

Found - Firmly set, the original 18x13x5" (45x33x12 cm) stone, record; 15x12x5" (38x30x12 cm) mkd. " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on West face, as recorded by P Applegate in 1891.  
New - I replace said stone with a 1x36" (25x91 cm) G.I. pipe, set 30" (76.20 cm) in the ground with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.3 cm) bronze disc mkd.:

The single remaining original BT, a Hemlock (record, larch) now 28" (71.12 cm) dia. with healed blazes brs. N.89°W., 94.7 ft. (28.86 m) to center of tree. Record: N.89°W., 92.40 ft. (28.16 m).

I deposit original stone alongside corner and mk. a new tree CS BT:

Hemlock, 28" (71 cm) dia. brs S.79°E., 61.80 ft. (18.83 m).

Corner lies on blazed N-S line about 250 ft (76.20 m) South of location marker on an 18" (45 cm) dia. hemlock alongside road C. S.70°E.
