The 1/4 sec. cor., nearly obliterated. One bearing tree is dead and the marks on the other bearing tree and the cor. are deeply overgrown.  
I reestablish the cor. in its original position as follows:  
The Original cor., a Madrone 12" dia. for 1/4 sec. cor. I remark 1/4 S22 on N. and 27 on S. side, from which  
A Madrone 16" dia., bears N.30°W., 24 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S22 BT.  
A Madrone 16" dia., bears S.70°W., 100 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S27 BT.
