The ¼ sec. cor. which is nearly obliterated. No trace found of the post. One bearing tree is dead and the other deeply overgrown.
I reestablish the cor. in its original position as follows:
Set a basalt stone 12x10x6 ins., 8" in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ on N. face, from which
A Madrone 16" dia., bears N.28°E., 38 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S23 BT.
A Fir 16" dia., bears S.32°E., 38 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S26 BT.
