Set a stone 14x10x4 ins., 9" in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on W. face; from which

A Fir 8" dia., bears S.71°E., 3 1/2 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S BT.

A Fir 12" dia., bears N.53°W., 31 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S BT.

Survey by Norman D. Price, For: W.A. McKenzie, Tiller, Oregon - April 5-18, 1955 - C.S. File 41/372

Determined at record bearing and distance from the original NW. bearing tree. All other evidence of the 1/4 sec. cor. is gone. At the corner point,

Set an iron pipe, 3 ft. long, 1 1/2" dia., 28" in the ground, mkd. RS33; from which the extant original bearing tree:

A sawed Fir stump 15" dia., bears N.53°W., 31 lks. dist. with section of tree mkd. "1/4 S" alongside.

And new bearing trees:

An Incense Cedar 5" dia., bears N.12 1/2°E., 36 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S23 RS33 BT.

A D.Fir 22" dia., bears S.51 1/2°W., 24 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S22 RS33 BT.
