- A Fir 14" dia., bears S.50°E., 70½ lks. dist. mkd. T31S R3W S23 BT.
- A Fir 15" dia., bears S.41½°W., 79 lks. dist. mkd. T31S R3W S22 BT.
- A Fir 18" dia., bears N.37¼°W., 57¼ lks. dist. mkd. T31S R3W S15 BT.
