A Sugar Pine 4 ft. dia., on line marked with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.

Found 59" Sugar Pine, (Angle Point) in good condition with 2 hack marks on each North and South sides, attention signs nailed to each N. and S. sides.

New BTs- 18" D.Fir bears S.22°W., 17.0 ft. scribed "T31S R3W S24 AP BT" with brass washer nailed to lower end of blaze.

10" D.Fir bears S22°E., 13.0 ft. scribed "T31S R2W S19 AP BT" with brass washer nailed to lower end of blaze.

Set aluminum post with boundary and monument signs 5 ft. South of enter of line tree.
