A Fir 15" dia., bears N.63°E., 36½ lks. dist. mkd. T31S R4W S17 BT.

A Hemlock 8" dia., bears S.46°E., 14½ lks. dist. mkd. T31S R4W S20 BT.

A Hemlock 6" dia., bears S.88°W., 64 lks. dist. mkd. T31S R4W S19 BT.

A Hemlock 6" dia. bears N.75°W. 19 lks mkd T31S R4W S18 BT

Found - An orig. 15" now 34" Fir bears N.63°E., 24.1 ft. Alive and well healed over double blaze.

An orig. 8" now 16" Hemlock bears S.46°E., 9.6 ft., alive and well healed with previously chopped blaze, visible scribing "31S".

The SW. and NW. orig. Hemlocks no longer here.

No sign of original 18"x10"x4" stone.

Set a 1" x 30" I.P. with brass cap mkd: Douglas Co. Surveyor

New - 14" hemlock, marked w/"X" bears S.41°W., 14.7 ft. to spike.
