The 1/4 sec. cor., perpetuated and recorded by Powell in 1966, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/4" dia., firmly set, projecting 19" above ground, with 1966 brass cap from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A Fir 44" dia., bears S.56 1/2°W., 36 3/4 lks. dist., no marks visible on opened blaze.

A down, decayed Madrone, size indeterminate, bears N.64 1/2°W., 22 1/2 lks. dist., no marks visible on rotted face.

and the remains of the bearing trees mkd. by Powell:

A Cedar 10" dia., bears N.51°E., 9 1/2 lks. dist. with scribe marks 1/4 S5 visible on partially healed blaze.

A down Cedar 18" dia., bears N.53 1/2°E., 17 lks. dist. with scribe marks 1/4 S8 CS visible on open blaze.
