Set a Fir post 3 ft. long, 3" square, 18" in ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S on the W. side, from which
A Fir 8" dia., bears S.70°E., 16 lks. mkd. 1/4 S BT.
A Laurel 8" dia., bears N.8°W., 7 lks. mkd. 1/4 S BT.

BLM Corrective Resurvey - John Jelley, Lynn Roseberry, Floyd Brooks, Under Group #s 320 and 614, - Surveyed June 1966 through May 1968. (DCSO records Vol. 35 Page(s) 14375)

Point for the 1/4 sec. cor., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
