Set a Maple post, 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 20" in the ground for the cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, mkd. T31S R6W S1 on NE.; S12 on SE.; S11 on SW.; and S2 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on S. edges, from which

A Laurel 6" dia., bears N.65°E., 59 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R6W S1 BT.

A Fir 24" dia., bears S.24°E., 44 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R6W S12 BT.

A Fir 26" dia., bears S.66°W., 117 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R6W S11 BT.

A Fir 12" dia., bears N.62°W., 64 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R6W S1 BT.

15" Fir N.62°W., 45 ft. has legible scribe, remark S2 BT.

At corner point found 4" x 4" wood post scribed S1-2-11-12.

Set a 3/4" x 24" I.P. 18" in ground, from which

6" Laurel bears S.49°W., 53 ft. mkd. S11 2880 BT.

4" Laurel bears N.36°E., 26 ft. mkd. S1 2880 BT.

The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, determined from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A sawed Fir stump 33" dia., bears S.10¼°E., 44 lks. dist., no marks visible. (Rec. S.24°E.)

A Fir snag 16" dia., bears N.66 3/4°W., 64 lks. dist., with axe marks visible on bark. (Rec. N.65°E., 59 lks.)

and trees mkd. by George J. Wenderoth R.L.S. No. 5 in 1966

A Madrone root crown, with sprouts, bears N.36½°E., 39½ lks. dist., no marks visible.

A stump hole bears S.49°W., 80 lks. dist., with a decayed and burned madrone alongside, with scribe marks SC visible on remains of blaze.
