A Fir 12" dia., bears N.36°W., 21 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT.

A Fir 20" dia., bears S.30°E., 30 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT.

Found both BTs for the ¼ corner.

The 12" Fir, now a 24" Fir, bearing N.36°W. for 21 lks. is in good condition with the old face grown over.

The 20" Fir, now a 38" Fir, bearing S.30°E. for 30 lks. has the legible bark scribe ¼S still on it.

I left my cruiser mark "K" on both BTs.

I reset the ¼ corner stake from the notes. The 3" x 4 ft. stake was marked ¼S 14 on East side, and ¼S 15 on the West side.
