Set Fir post, 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground, for cor. to secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, marked T31S R7W S12 on NE.; S13 on SE.; S14 on SW.; and S11 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on E. and 4 notches on S. edges, from which

- A Fir 14" dia., bears N.45°E., 36 lks. mkd T31S R7W S12 BT
- A Fir 14" dia., bears S.70°E., 29 lks. mkd T31S R7W S13 BT
- A Fir 30" dia., bears S.55°W., 16 lks. mkd T31S R7W S14 BT
- A Fir 28" dia., bears N.48°W., 54 lks. mkd T31S R7W S11 BT

The Sec. cor., determined at record distance from the remaining original bearing trees:

- A root hole bears S.7°E., 29 lks., with a down Fir 15" dia., alongside, with scribe marks T31S R7W S13 BT visible on bark blaze.
- A Fir 35" dia., bears N.51½°W., 54 lks., with no marks remaining on opened blaze. (Rec. N.48°W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:
