25" D. Fir bears N.78°E. 31.5 ft. (Rec. N.78°E. 31.73 ft.) with a healed face and D.C. tag.  
21" D. Fir bears S.50°E. 23.8 ft. rec. S.48½°E., 23.51' with a healed face, we re-tag  
New - 12" D. Fir bears N.15°W. 20.4 ft. We scribe T31S R8W S11 BT and tag.  
The monument lies in a steep, washed out, dry draw running North, approx. 200 ft. North of gravel surface BLM logging road # 31-1-11.1. Top of monument lies at ground level. A galvanized steel U-post bears North 1.0 feet. NAD 83 (2011) latitude N.42°52'59.86" longitude W. 123°36'12.99".
