A fir, 24" dia., bears N.30°E., 11 lks., mkd: S8 ¼ S BT.

A fir, 48" dia., bears S.45°W., 20 lks., mkd: S7 ¼ S BT.

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Found - 24" D.Fir, now still about 24" stump, N.30°E., 7.3 ft. scribe partly visible "¼" "B", scribing partly over grown.

SW BT now stump hole.

No trace of stone.

40" D.Fir stump N.73°E., 9.7 ft. scribed BT ¼ S8 T31 R9W (unrecorded)

New BTs- 18" D.Fir stump N.65°W., 47.3 ft. mkd. ¼ S7 CS BT.  
No trees available.

Note - This corner lies on steep south slope. Also it is approx. 80.0 ft. E of small ridge & 250.0 ft. W of ravine. NE of cor. in head of ravine is a rock bluff.
